The remaining terms and conditions of the settlement agreement are incorporated and made an order of the Enforcement Committee.

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SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT IN TERMS OF SECTION 6B(7)(a) OF THE FINANCIAL INSTITUTIONS (PROTECTION OF FUNDS) ACT, 28 OF 2001

1. The parties

- 1.1. The parties to the agreement are the Registrar of Financial Services Providers ("the Registrar") herein represented by German Emanuel Anderson in his capacity as the Deputy Registrar of Financial Services Providers; and
- 1.2. The Respondent is No Doubt Trading CC ("Respondent") is a close corporation incorporated in terms of the laws of the Republic of South Africa, bearing the registration number 2009/228796/23. The Respondent is represented by Mr Zamokwakhe Khumalo ("Mr Khumalo") in his capacity as the member of the Respondent. Mr Khumalo warrants that he is authorized by the Respondent to conclude this agreement.

2. Whereas

- 2.1. The Registrar is of the opinion that the Respondent contravened the provisions of section 3(a) of the Financial Advisory Services Regulations, 2003 (Regulations) prescribed in terms of section 35 of the Financial Advisory and Intermediary Services Act, no 37 of 2002.
- 2.2. The Respondent wishes to enter into a settlement agreement with the Registrar as contemplated in section 6B(7)(a) of the Financial Institutions (Protection of Funds) Act, No 28 of 2001 ("the FI Act").

3. The contravention

- 3.1. It is agreed between the parties that the Respondent contravened the provisions of section 3(a) of the Regulations in that:
 - 3.1.1. The Respondent during the period 08 April 2011 to 09 January 2012 and within the Republic of South Africa, canvassed for, marketed and/or advertised the rendering of financial services by a foreign based company, incorporated in England and Wales, CB Financial Services Limited that trades as One Financial Markets (hereafter referred to as "One Financial Markets").



(C)

3.1.2. One Financial Markets was not authorized as a financial services provider nor was it a lawfully appointed representative of an authorized financial services provider.

4. The mitigating circumstances

- 4.1. It is also agreed that the following mitigating factors are relevant to the matter:
 - 4.1.1. The Respondent accepted responsibility for the contravention;
 - 4.1.2. The Respondent fully co-operated with the Registrar's investigation and the enforcement action.

5. The agreed penalty

- 5.1. In the light of the above, and in terms of section 6B(7)(a) of the FI Act, the parties have agreed that the Respondent will pay a penalty of R25 000 on or before the 1 May 2012 in settlement of the matter.
- 5.2. The parties humbly request that the Honorable Chairperson makes the settlement an order, as envisaged in section 6B(7)(b) of the FI Act.



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6. Other conditions

- 6.1. This agreement is subject to approval by the Enforcement Committee and the parties specifically record that they are aware of the possibility that the Enforcement Committee may not accept the terms of this agreement. If the Enforcement Committee declines to make this agreement an order, then in such event this agreement will be null and void.
- 6.2. If the respondent does not comply with the terms of this agreement and it is necessary for the Financial Services Board (FSB) to proceed with legal proceedings, the Respondent herewith consents to pay all legal costs to the FSB on the Attorney and Client scale in terms of the High Court Rules inclusive of collection commission and Value Added Tax.
- 6.3. No leniency or postponement given by the FSB to the Respondent or any amendment to the terms and conditions of this agreement will be binding unless such postponement, leniency or amendment is reduced to writing and signed by the parties. Any leniency or postponement granted by the Registrar or any amendment to this Agreement shall not be a novation of the cause of action in terms whereof the Respondent was found to have contravened the Act.





- 6.4. Any receipt of a payment by the FSB after the due date shall be without prejudice to any of the rights of the FSB.
- 6.5. This Agreement constitutes the whole agreement between the parties in respect of the offer to pay a penalty.
- 6.6. The parties choose as their domicillum citandi et executandi their respective address set out below for all purposes arising out of or in connection with this agreement at which addresses all the processes and notices arising out of or in connection with this agreement, its breach or termination may validly be served upon or delivered to the parties.
