FINANCIAL ADVISORY AND INTERMEDIARY SERVICES ACT, 2002

EXEMPTION OF CERTAIN FSPs WHO ARE LONG-TERM INSURERS OR SHORT-TERM INSURERS FROM SECTION 13 OF THE GENERAL CODE OF CONDUCT

I, Caroline Dey da Silva, Deputy Registrar of Financial Services Providers, hereby exempt under section 44(4) of the Financial Advisory and Intermediary Services Act, 2002, certain FSPs who are long-term insurers or short-term insurers from section 13 of the General Code of Conduct, to the extent and subject to the conditions set out in the Schedule.

SCHEDULE

EXEMPTION OF CERTAIN FSPs WHO ARE LONG-TERM INSURERS OR SHORT-TERM INSURERS FROM SECTION 13 OF THE GENERAL CODE OF CONDUCT

Definitions

- In this Schedule, "the Act" means the Financial Advisory and Intermediary Services Act, 2002 (Act No. 37 of 2002), any word or expression to which a meaning is assigned in the Act shall have that meaning, and unless the context otherwise indicates-
 - "General Code of Conduct", means the General Code of Conduct for Authorised Financial Services Providers and Representatives, 2003;
 - "Insurance FSP" means an authorised FSP who is also a long-term insurer or a short-term insurer:
 - "Long-term Insurer" means a person registered as a long-term insurer under the Long-term Insurance Act (Act,-No. 52 of 1998);

"Short-term Insurer" means a person registered as a short-term insurer under the Short-term Insurance Act (Act,-No. 53 of 1998).

Extent of exemption and condition

- 2 (a) An insurance FSP is exempted from section 13 of the General Code of Conduct.
 - (b) The exemption, subject to paragraph 3, is valid for a period of five years from the date referred to in paragraph 4.

Amendment and withdrawal of exemption and conditions

- 3 The exemption or conditions referred to in paragraph 2 are subject to-
 - (a) amendment by the registrar by notice on the official web site; and
 - (b) withdrawal in like manner.

Short title and commencement

This exemption is called the Exemption of certain FSPs who are long-term insurers or short-term insurers from section 13 of the General Code of Conduct, 2015, and takes effect on 22 May 2015.
