REQUEST FOR INFORMATION – CRYPTO ASSET RELATED ACTIVITIES PERFORMED BY FSPs

1. REQUEST FOR INFORMATION

- 1.1 The Financial Sector Conduct Authority (“FSCA”), under section 131 of the Financial Sector Regulation Act, 2017 (Act No. 9 of 2017) (“FSRA”), hereby requests Financial Services Providers (“FSPs”) to furnish information to the FSCA by completing the electronic survey.
- 1.2 The purpose of the Information Request is to assist the FSCA in obtaining a better understanding of the extent to which FSPs are currently operating in the crypto asset environment. It is envisaged that the requested information will assist the FSCA in making more informed decisions regarding the potential future regulation of crypto asset related activities.

2. FORMAT OF INFORMATION REQUESTED AND TIMELINE FOR SUBMISSION

3. FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH REQUEST

- 3.1 A failure to provide the specified information by or within the timeframe specified constitutes an offence under section 267 of the FSRA.
