
APPLICATION FOR RECONSIDERATION I.T.O. SECTION 230 OF THE FINANCIAL SECTOR REGULATION ACT 9 OF 2017

The application for reconsideration is summarily dismissed in terms of sec 234(4) of the FSR Act.

This Tribunal does not deal with appeals as the applicant apparently thinks. Application for reconsideration must comply with the rules, which this one does not - see rule 11.

The applicant admits that it does not have any legal interest in the debarment of the representative but wishes to act in the public good to have him debarred. That admission on its own establishes that the applicant is not a person aggrieved by the decision of the FSCA.

In laying the complaint, the applicant acted as informer/witness/complainant, much the same as any informer in a criminal case. But that does not make the informer a party to the case who can appeal.
