FSCA issues a public warning against Ameer and Sons (Pty) Ltd

The Financial Sector Conduct Authority (FSCA) warns the public to exercise caution when conducting financial services business with Ameer and Sons (Pty) Ltd purporting to be authorised as a financial services provider (FSP) and a Crypto Asset FSP.

It has come to the FSCA's attention that the Ameer and Sons claimed to have obtained an FSP license and a Crypto Asset FSP license from the FSCA. Ameer and Sons applied for an FSP license and were awarded a temporary license numbered FSP 54982. Ameer and Sons used this temporary FSP number on its communication to imply that it was authorised as an FSP, despite abandoning its application for authorisation. Ameer and Sons, however, were not authorised as an FSP. While the FSCA does not comment on the specifics of Ameer and Sons' business, it must be noted that Ameer and Sons is not authorised by the FSCA to provide financial services to members of the public. Ameer and Sons failed to respond to FSCA enquiries.
