

FSCA warns the public warning against Mr Motsamai David Marumo and FX Trading Revolution LLC

The Financial Sector Conduct Authority (FSCA) warns the public to be cautious when conducting financial services business with Mr. Motsamai David Marumo (Marumo) and FX Trading Revolution LLC (FX Trading).

It has come to the attention of the FSCA that Marumo and FX Trading are soliciting funds from members of the public for investment purposes, by offering unrealistic returns. Marumo and FX Trading may be rendering financial services, by offering to trade in forex and shares on behalf of members of the public, with the promise of guaranteed profits. Marumo and FX Trading are promising investors guaranteed monthly returns of 10%. The FSCA points out that that profits resulting from trading cannot be guaranteed, and that any offer of unrealistic returns must be treated with utmost caution.

Without commenting on the nature of Marumo and FX Tradings' business, the FSCA points out that they are not authorised in terms of any financial sector law to provide financial products or render financial services. Trading in forex derivatives and shares on behalf of clients requires an FSP licence. Marumo could not be contacted.

The public is strongly urged to exercise caution when considering investment or trading offers on social media platforms or any unsolicited (cold-called) offers.

It is highly recommended that the public verify:

- that an entity or individual is authorised by the FSCA to provide financial products and services, including giving recommendations about how to invest.
- what category of advice the person is registered to provide, as there are instances where companies or people are registered to provide basic advice for a low-risk product and then offer advice on far more complex and risky products.
- that the FSP number utilised by the entity or individual offering financial services matches to name of the FSP on the FSCA database.
